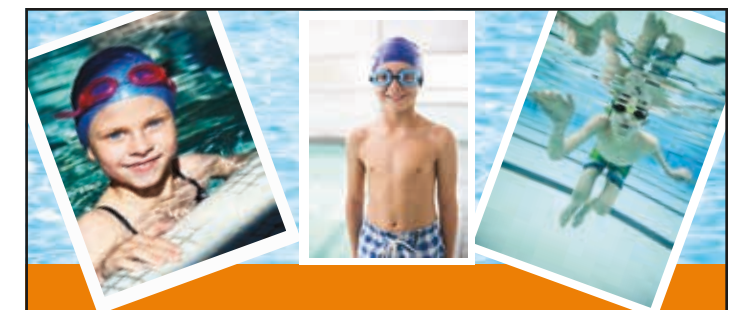

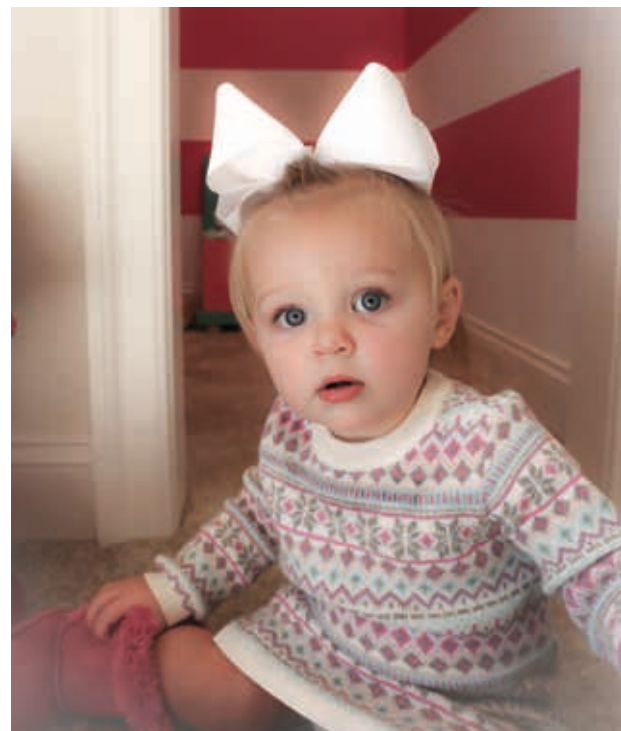

2 bulbs fennel | 4 oranges | handful of black olives
extra-virgin olive oil | salt and pepper to taste
1/4 toasted pine nuts (optional)

- › Cut off fennel tops, and peel off outer layer of fennel bulb.
- › Thinly slice fennel across with a sharp knife or on a mandoline, if possible. You want the slice to be as thin as possible. Place in bowl.
- › Cut oranges into sections ('supreme') by slicing off the top and bottom, and cutting between each section to avoid getting any membrane on the slices. Place in bowl with fennel.
- › Remove pits from olives by smashing gently on a cutting board with the side of a knife. This splits the olive and makes pit removal easy. Add to bowl.
- › Sprinkle salad with salt and pepper to taste and add olive oil to dress. Add toasted pine nuts if you like.

Compression Socks! What's the deal!?

The evidence appears anecdotal, but the perceived recovery benefits can't be denied.

With manufacturers claiming compression socks and tights increase oxygen delivery, decrease lactic acid, prevent cramps, and minimize muscle fatigue, the wonder garments have been the hottest new item in athletic circles. The Pattersons just celebrated their 46th wedding anniversary. Cheers!

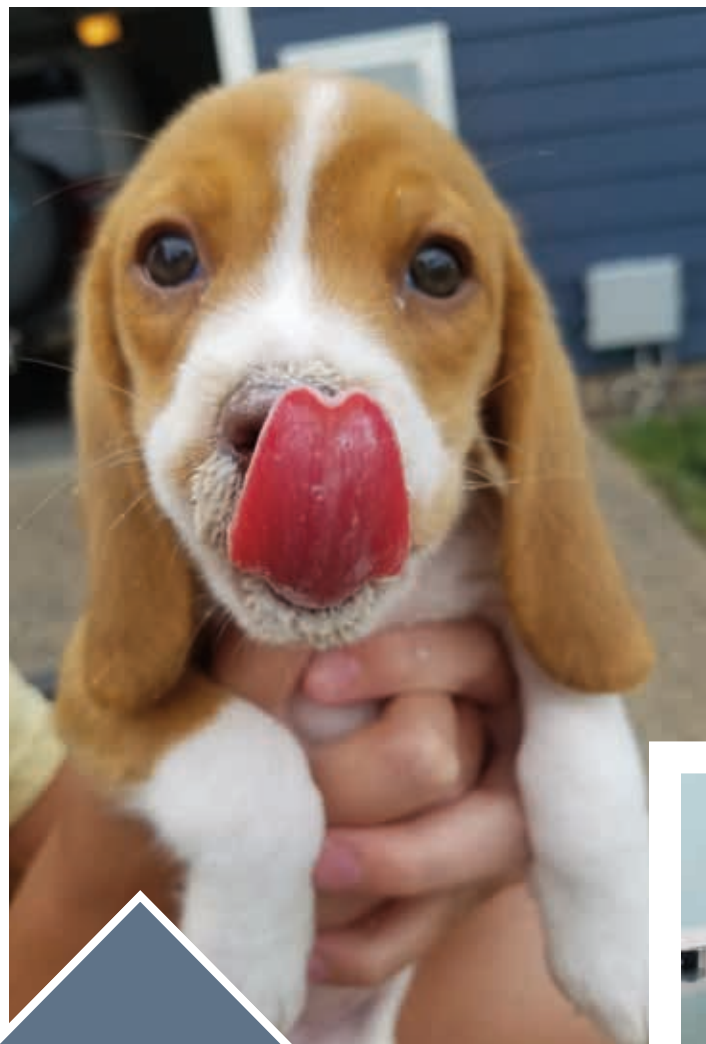
